Goal

WP3 aims first to offer **a new perspective on the history of militant culture** by emphasizing the link between political experience and material culture. One of the challenges is to study the evolution of the concept of political materiality over time and to create new grounds for research and new narratives regarding **the mobility of objects** or the **emotional role of political objects**.

Expected results

WP3 also seeks to enable close cooperation and exchange of knowledge between **researchers, archivists and museum curators** to foster a cross fertilization of experience on material participation : how to collect, catalogue and exhibit political objects regarding new archival practices ?

Among the expected results are :

- a **mapping of meta data models of objects** in the network of archives and museums
- an **online exhibition** on militant objects
