Goal

WP 4 explores **how alternative social and media archives preserve and transmit the representation of political dissent** through activist media practices in historical and comparative perspectives. It will focus on the knowledge **exchange of archiving practices, digitization strategies and methods of public presentation** of the audio-visual archival holdings in the partner institutions, many of them preserving materials not accessible in national or central archives.

Expected results

Among the expected results are :

- To **map multi-media archival collections** on political dissent in the partners' holdings
- To develop **cross-disciplinary collaboration** between archivists and researchers on the issue of **web activism**
- To elaborate **new cutting-edge practices for the digitisation and access of the multilingual media resources** by both professional and non-specialist users
- To design **new forms of cooperation on public presentation** of the material for educational and civic engagement
